ENSTOR Begins Development of Waha Gas Storage Facility

ENSTOR, a unit of ScottishPower (NYSE: SPI), has begun development of a 7.2 billion cubic foot (BCF) high deliverability salt cavern gas storage project in West Texas.

The Waha Storage and Hub Facility is located three miles from the existing Waha trading point in West Texas. The site was acquired as part of ENSTOR's acquisition of assets from Aquila in December 2002 that included the Katy gas storage facility near Houston. The Waha project is expected to be developed in three phases over the next six years, with the first phase operational by 2006.

"ENSTOR had a successful open season for Waha storage last fall with market interest surpassing the capacity we were offering," said ENSTOR president Matt Morrow. "The Waha facility is strategically located near a major trading hub with excellent pipeline access. It complements PPM's existing operations in Canada and in Texas, enhancing our ability to provide firm storage and hub services to the North American market."

ENSTOR's gas storage business includes a majority interest and operation of the 44 Bcf Alberta Hub storage facility in western Canada and ownership and operation of the 21 Bcf Katy storage facility near Houston, Texas.
