ENSTOR Announces New Service at Katy Storage Hub

KATY, Texas – ENSTOR Operating Company, a unit of ScottishPower, will begin providing title transfer tracking services ("TTT") August 1, 2005 at the Katy Storage and Transportation Facility in Katy, Texas. All market participants will be able to utilize this service as a pooling point which will be listed on the ICE trading platform as "Katy - ENSTOR Pool." The TTT services will allow ENSTOR account holders who tender gas for delivery to the Katy Storage Hub to trade gas at the facility pursuant to ENSTOR's TTT Services. Fees for TTT Services will be \$.001 per MMBTU for each customer transacting an intra-hub transfer.

"We are working toward making Katy a more liquid and efficient trading point by providing pooling services as more financial players enter this market" said Patrick De Ville, ENSTOR's vice president of marketing.

The Katy facility, located 20 miles west of Houston, has a working capacity of 21 Bcf and a maximum deliverability of 700,000/d. The facility has interconnects with 13 pipelines and serves a diversified customer base in multiple market areas.

The ENSTOR storage business also includes the Waha Storage Hub, which is currently under construction and will have interconnects with El Paso, Oasis, Gulf Terra, TUFCO, Lonestar, Westex, Duke, NNG, as well as a potential interconnect with Transwestern. The Waha Storage Hub will have a total storage capacity of 9.5 Bcf and maximum deliverability of 800,000/d. ENSTOR also plans to expand its 4.5 Bcf Grama Ridge reservoir facility to 6.0 BCF. Grama Ridge sits within 80 miles of the Waha Storage Hub.
