ENSTOR Extends Open Season for Houston Storage Hub

HOUSTON — ENSTOR Operating Company, LLC, is extending by approximately three weeks the previously announced Open Season for its Houston Hub Storage and Transportation, L. P. affiliate in light of recent supply disruptions in the Gulf Coast. Houston Storage Hub will provide critical coastal inland storage about 75 miles downstream from LNG facilities already proposed on the Sabine Pass by Cheniere and Exxon.

ENSTOR will be accepting bids for firm storage capacity at Houston Storage Hub for service commencing April 1, 2008. The period for non-binding bids has been extended to 5:00 p.m. CST on Nov. 4, 2005. All successful bidding parties will be contacted to further negotiate contract specifics in late November 2005.

ENSTOR's Houston Storage Hub is designed to interconnect with three interstate pipelines (Trunkline, Transcontinental Gas Pipeline and Natural Gas Pipeline/Texok) and one intrastate pipeline (Kinder Morgan Texas). The facility will utilize both gas and electric driven horsepower to provide firm storage services of approximately 9 annual cycles. Total working storage capacity will be 12 Bcf upon completion, with maximum daily deliverability of 1,000,000 Mcf.

The ENSTOR Houston Storage Hub could also be utilized as a header system allowing customers to capture value between the various pipeline locations. The Houston Hub will allow customers to balance the needs of the market and variable supply sources with the flexible services of a domal salt storage project.
