ENSTOR Announces Open Season for Waha, Katy and Alberta Firm Storage

ENSTOR, a unit of ScottishPower's PPM Energy, Inc., will be accepting bids for firm storage capacity at its Waha and Katy Storage Hubs beginning on Oct. 10, 2003. Non-binding bids will be due by 5:00 p.m. CST on October 31, 2003. All bidding parties will be contacted to further negotiate contract specifics in early November, 2003.

ENSTOR's Waha Storage Hub is proposed to interconnect with three interstate pipelines and four intrastate pipelines and provide firm storage services of between four and 12 annual cycles. Total working storage capacity would be six Bcf upon completion of this facility and have a maximum daily deliverability of 300,000 MMcf per day. The ENSTOR Waha Storage Hub could also be utilized as a header system allowing customers to capture value between the various pipeline locations.

ENSTOR's Katy Storage Hub is interconnected with eight Texas intrastate and four interstate pipelines and has a total storage capacity of 21 Bcf. Firm storage services of up to five annual cycles will be provided at this heavily traded location. Katy is located at the crossroads between the Texas intrastate, Gulf Coast and Midwest markets. The ENSTOR Katy Storage Hub can also be utilized as a header system providing additional services to customers in this area.
